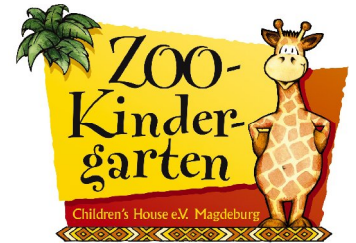

Requirements:

- English is your native language.
- You have a **"B.A. in Early Childhood Education" or "B.A. in kindergarten"**
- You are flexible & able to work 40 hours a week (anytime between 7AM – 6 PM /irregular hours)
- You are willing to gain basic knowledge in German language by taking weekend classes
- You are a creative, enthusiastic and responsible individual who likes to work with children
- You have at least 1 year of work experience with children (ages 3-6 years old)
- You are able to work both independently and as part of a team

Your work environment:

- You will lead one of the two groups of children together with your German team partner. Each group has 13 to 18 children.
- You will only be talking with children in your own language throughout their daily activities ("Immersion Concept").
- You will prepare stimulating, enjoyable and informative learning materials in English on ecology, environment, and zoo-related topics ("Green Immersion").
- You will be taking children on small field trips to the park or the zoo for better understanding ("Green Immersion").

- an enthusiastic and friendly team with a shared interest in children, animals and nature
- assistance with the bilingual teaching approach
